Dear Community Member:

The Orange County Health Department and Orange County Emergency Management invite you to join the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program. The CERT program teaches people how to provide basic emergency response services in their neighborhood. After a major disaster, first responders may not be able to meet service demands in every community. Factors like the number of victims, communication failures, and blocked roads may delay emergency response. In a situation like this, community members would have to rely on each other for immediate needs until professional responders arrive.

We want multiple neighborhoods in Orange County to have a CERT. Orange County CERT members receive hands-on training in emergency preparedness, fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, disaster psychology, personal safety, and animal protection. Training ends with a drill where teams practice newly learned skills. Participants receive educational material and response gear (hard hat, reflective vest, safety whistle, identification badge, and more). After training, teams function as self-sustaining units.

The Los Angeles Fire Department started CERT in 1985 to prepare citizens for earthquakes. The program was so successful that FEMA made it a national program. While Orange County doesn't have a high risk for earthquakes, we do have our share of natural disasters. Hurricanes, ice storms, and flooding have all hit our area. Our county could also be faced with terrorism, chemical emergencies, and disease outbreaks, all of which could delay emergency response services.

Please promote CERT in your community and register for an upcoming training session. A group of 5 or more people can form a team. Individuals are also welcome to register. **There is no registration fee and training materials are provided at no cost.** Our brochure, training calendar, and registration form are enclosed.

# Join Orange County CERT

We can't predict the next disaster for Orange County, but we can prepare for it!

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program teaches participants how to provide basic emergency response services after a disaster. Persons living or working in Orange County can form a CERT to meet critical needs in their neighborhood or workplace when first responders are unavailable. Starting a CERT requires completion of a 5-week training program taught in or near your community by skilled health and safety professionals. All training is **free** and participants receive educational materials and emergency response gear.







# Here's What You'll Learn:

# **Emergency Preparedness**

This course will teach you how to prepare yourself, your family, and your neighborhood for natural and man-made disasters. Information on making an emergency plan and disaster supply kit will be provided.

# **Emergency Medical Operations I & II**

In these two courses, emergency service providers will teach you how to use basic first-aid to treat life threatening conditions. You'll learn triage principles and how to treat airway obstructions, bleeding, and burns.

#### **CERT Organization**

This course will show you how to maintain your CERT and document your team's neighborhood response activities.

# **Personal Safety and Property Protection**

This course will teach you how to identify and handle personal safety threats when responding to a disaster. This course will also give you useful recommendations for staying safe and healthy when recovering from a disaster.

# **Fire Safety**

In this course, a fire safety professional will teach you basic lessons in fire chemistry, hazardous materials, and fire suppression. You'll practice putting out small fires with a portable fire extinguisher.

#### **Light Search and Rescue**

This course will teach you how to lead safe search and rescue missions. You'll learn how to search for victims and safely remove victims from a disaster scene.

### **Disaster Psychology**

This course overviews the psychological impact of a disaster on rescuers and victims. You will learn how to provide "psychological first-aid" to support team members and victims without over stressing yourself.


#### **Animal Care and Protection**

This course will teach you how to make a disaster plan for your pets and how to provide basic first aid to injured animals. You will also learn safety precautions to take in an encounter with a wild animal.
