



## **NOTICE OF STREET CLOSINGS**

On Sunday afternoon, December 13<sup>th</sup>, the **Sixth Annual Southern Village Holiday 5k and Family Fun Run**, presented by Harrington Bank and Duke Medicine, will be held beginning at 2:00 PM starting at the Green. Net proceeds will benefit Chapel Hill Service League.

For the safety of the runners and walkers, it will be necessary to restrict traffic on the streets where the race takes place (shown on map at [www.sv5k.com](http://www.sv5k.com)):

Aberdeen from Graylyn to Copperline; Copperline from Aberdeen to Greenview; Greenview from Copperline to Parkside Circle; Parkside Circle from Greenview to Arlen Park; Edgewater Circle from Arlen Park to Parkview Crescent, also from Brookgreen to Graylyn; Parkview Crescent from Edgewater Circle to Highgrove; Highgrove from Parkview Crescent to Hillspring (south end), also from Hillspring (north end) to Westside, also from Glenhaven to Brookgreen; all of Hillspring Drive; Westside from Highgrove to Glade; Glade from Westside to Highgrove; Glenhaven "loop"; Brookgreen from Edgewater to Highgrove; all of Graylyn.

We regret any inconvenience it may cause but we hope by alerting you in advance that any problem is minimized.

We ask that you move your cars off the streets to permit racers more room to run and walk. The streets will be closed only while the racers are passing and will be opened as soon as the last racer clears the area. No one section of the course will be closed for more than 30 minutes. All streets will be fully open to traffic no later than 3:45 PM.

Finally, we ask that you contain the family pooch that afternoon. Even though your dog is friendly, it would not be a good idea if he or she got in the middle of a pack of 300+ runners!
